


VICTORY CLOSETS

an attractive custom closet using high-quality, durable materials while keeping the product sensibly priced. He created a parts-based system with self-locking components that can be reconfigured by the homeowner without needing any tools or skill. This sets Victory Closets apart from other companies. The homeowner is not limited by their original design; they can add to or reconfigure their design to accommodate different storage needs for a change of seasons or lifestyle, such as swapping summer sandals for taller winter boots or replacing shelves with hanging storage in kids' closets as they grow.

A reconfigurable custom closet system has many advantages. "Because our closet system can be reconfigured, you don't have to take inventory of every item of clothing. There's a lot less pressure during the design process because you'll have the flexibility to move shelves, drawers and hanging clothes locations after the installation and whenever you want to change in the future. Some of my customers keep the same layout from day one, but some will move things around as they start to fill the closet and get organized. It's great having that versatility," said Ahart.

When designing closets, Greg and his team focus on maximizing the available storage space and considering the customer's wish list for the storage they need. Do they want drawers, do they need long-hanging for dresses? Do they want storage for shoes, jewelry, purses, or ties and belts? "We also take note of any non-standard items in the closet that need to have their own space, such as luggage. Some clients like to store their luggage in the closet, so it's close by to pack for trips."

These are other areas of the home where you spend a lot of time, and having things neat and organized can really help you to be more efficient and even feel more relaxed and make those daily tasks less daunting. 
also add shelf dividers to maximize your storage space and showcase your collection of shoes or smaller items.
